SWINE FLU



What is swine flu?

Swine fl u is like the fl u that we usually see each winter. It is caused by a vin (Infl uenza A). There are lots of different viruses that cause fl u.

How do people become infected?

Swine fi u can spreadfrom person to person when thespray, made by a sick person when they cough or sneeze, is breathed in by someone else. It can also spread by touching a surface where there is virus and then touching the nose, eyes and mouth.

What will happen if I catch it?

Most types of fi u cause the same illness having a temperature, coughing, feeling tired, not wanting to eat, a headache and sore throat. Some people have also reported being sick andhaving diarrhoea.

If you feel unwell it is likely that your parent or carer will contact the helpline, either on the phone or on the web, and they will tell them what to do to look after you.

What can I do to get better from swine flu?

There are special medicines called antivirals which are used to treat people who are unwell with the virus. Your parent or carer will look after you and tell you what to do to get better again.

As swine fluis a virus it cannot be treated with antibiotics as these are used to treat infections caused by bacteria

What can I do to protect myself?

There are a few things that everyone can do to stop the virus from spreading around and making other people unwell. These include:

- Put some paper tissues in your pocket or bag and use these when you want to cough or sneeze to catch the droplets.
- If you have used a tissuethrow these away in a bin.
- If you have sneezed or coughed in your hands and even if you have used a tissuestill wash your hands with soap and water to kill the virus and stop it spreading to other people.
